1 授業目標

2 This course introduces some basic concepts in the relationship between language and mind.

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4 授業概要・授業計画

5 This course begins by dealing with the fundamental questions of what is language and what is the mind.
6 The remainder of the course then looks at various ways of understanding how the two are related. Students
7 will conduct some simple in-class experiments in order to examine the relationship and will also conduct
8 a larger experiment as a final project. Students will consider how language is represented in the mind
9 in terms of both first and second language acquisition as well as how language is processed with respect
10 to the limits of human memory.
